Drama Class Descriptions

Kinderdrama (Ages 3-4) - Thursdays from 3:15-4:00

Students step into the world of imagination and make-believe as each week we make a different story come to life with songs, costumes, props, and art activities. Students use the art of storytelling to act out various nursery rhymes and childhood favorites. **Tuition is \$40 a month**

Creative Dramatics (Ages 5-6) - Mondays from 3:15-4:00

Does your child LOVE to make-believe? This interactive theatrical journey takes young creative minds into the world of theatre as they create characters and participate in creative play and improvisation with a focus on acting and movement. Each week a classic fairytale or Disney story will be brought to life as the students work as a team on recreating the story in class. Students will also focus on Readers Theatre that introduces students to short skits and plays. **Tuition is \$40 a month**

Lights- Camera- Action- Acting I (Ages 7-10) - Wednesdays from 4:00-5:00

Learn basic acting techniques, tips and terms. This fun format introduces students to warm-ups, stage direction, theater etiquette, character analysis, scene work and more. Working with theater games and activities, students learn to express themselves and learn basic theater terminology while exploring character development, active listening, problem solving, and teamwork. A short performance will be held for friends and family at the end of the semester. **Tuition is \$45 a month**

Improv- Intermediate Acting (Ages 8-16) - Thursdays from 4:15-5:15

This class is perfect for students who have already mastered Acting I and have a good foundation of acting techniques.. **Tuition is \$45 a month**

Dramatic Acting (Advanced Acting (Ages 12-18) - Mondays from 4:30-5:30

This class is for students that are currently enrolled in the 2010 Resident Touring Company, and for advanced theatre students. **Resident Company Requirement -Tuition is \$45 a month**

Art I Class (Ages 10 and up)- Tuesdays from 4:30-5:30- Learn the basic elements of art and design in this one of a kind class with San Angelo Broadway Academy's costumer (students younger than 10 will need to be approved by teacher).

Dance Class Descriptions

Creative Dance I- (Ages3) Mondays from 2:30-3:15

Designed to develop your child's movement and classroom skills through creative play, music and dance. This class will have a larger focus on ballet technique and gross motors skills. This class will prepare students to move into a classical ballet class or other movement class. **Tuition is \$40 a month**

Creative Dance II- (Ages 4-5) Mondays from 3:15-4:00- A continuation of Creative Dance I

Pre-School Ballet/Tap(Ages 4-5)- Tuesdays from 3:15-4:00

Little ones will learn the basics of dance, including the positions of the arms and feet, and a basic introductory level steps. The class will also encourage the growth of gross motor skills with the emphasis on ballet and tap **Tuition is \$40 a month**

Pre-Ballet (Ages 5-7)- Mondays from 4:00-4:45

This class emphasizes the development of classical ballet skills with a focus on proper placement, alignment and coordination of port de bras with leg and footwork. Students will learn ballet vocabulary through barre and center work while building strength and flexibility. This class is appropriate for students who have had Creative Movement II and those just starting a ballet class. (If students are 5 and have successfully finished Creative Dance II they can enroll in Pre-Ballet).

Beginning Ballet Technique (Ages 6-up)- Wednesdays from 3:30-4:30

This class continues to emphasize the development of classical ballet skills with a focus on proper placement, alignment and coordination of port de bras with leg and footwork. Students will continue to build their ballet vocabulary through barre and center work while building strength and flexibility. This class will begin to focus more on combinations at center and across the floor. This class is appropriate for students who have had at least one year of beginning ballet or pre-ballet or older students who are beginning ballet. **Tuition is \$45 a month**

Beginning Tap (Ages 6 and up)- Tuesdays from 4:00-4:45

An introduction to the rhythm and coordination of tap dance. Students will learn the proper tap technique to create clean distinct sounds and later be introduced to rhythmic layering **Tuition is \$40 a month or if taken with Jazz it is \$70**

Beginning Jazz (Ages 6 and up)- Tuesdays from 4:45-5:30

An introduction to the energy and dynamic of jazz technique. Students will be introduced to parallel positions and begin to explore the direct, decisive, and sharp facet of jazz technique and its various rhythms. Students will work on the fundamentals including flexibility, jumps and turns **Tuition is \$40 a month or if taken with Tap is \$70**

Intermediate Ballet- (Ages 8 and up) Tuesdays from 4:30-5:30

This hour long class is a continuation of Beginning Ballet and continues to build students repertoire of ballet skills and terminology through warm-up, barre work, and center. Students will refine their motor skills and learn control of their own bodies while discovering the joy of classical ballet. This class is appropriate for students who have had at least two years of any basic ballet training.

Junior Hip Hop- (Ages 8-12) Mondays from 4:45-5:45

This class teaches rhythm, musicality, coordination, and age-appropriate hip hop choreography with no suggestive music/movement. This is an excellent class for high-energy boys and girls who want to take a fast and fun dance class.

Intermediate Jazz (Ages 8-13)- Thursdays from 4pm-5pm

A continuation of Beginning Jazz. This class is for students with a sound dance background. Dynamic, energy, placement, improvisation, and intermediate level jumps and turns will be worked on. Classes will alternate between classical jazz, pop jazz and musical theatre jazz **Tuition is \$45 a month or if taken with Tap is \$80**

Intermediate /Advanced Tap (Ages 8-13) Thursdays from 5pm-6pm

This course is for dancers with previous tap experience or who have successfully mastered a majority of elements taught in our Beginner Tap course. Students will learn full length tap combinations that will focus on precise steps and foot articulation, rhythmic awareness and layering, movement through space and will incorporate the use of arm and full body dynamics used in performing tap **Tuition is \$45 a month or if taken with Jazz is \$80**

Advanced Jazz (Ages 11 and up)- Wednesdays from 5:30-6:30: A continuation of Intermediate Jazz **Tuition is \$45 a month or if taken with Tap is \$80**

Open Hip Hop (Ages 12 and up) - Thursdays from 6pm-7pm

Groove to the beats of the latest songs as you warm-up and learn fast paced and exciting dances. Hip Hop class is a very stylized form of street dance using isolations, popping, and free styled movement. These upbeat high tempo classes aim to develop not only technique, but self confidence and stage performance as well. **Tuition is \$45 a month or \$12 a class**

Class and Tuition Policies

- **Payment-** A \$25 non-refundable deposit (applicable to tuition) per class is required at registration. Tuition is payable monthly in advance, **due by the 1st of each month and considered late on the 8th** . No refunds or adjustments due to absences. Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable. Make-up classes are encouraged and must be taken within the month missed. Classes are based upon 4 classes a month. **A \$5.00 late fee will be assessed to all accounts not current on the 8th of each month. Late Fees will be enforced** and a \$15.00 fee will be charged on all checks returned by the bank. . No statements will be sent out, unless your account is past due. ***If you wish to terminate enrollment, written notification is required before the 1st of the upcoming month. Monthly billing will continue until the office receives written notice.*** Tuition is due for the month in which you drop. A
- **Class Confirmation** - Once registered, you will receive a letter confirming your enrollment, stating your monthly tuition rate, the class location, class calendar, and other general information.
- **Cancellation Policy** - If you wish to terminate enrollment, written notification is required before the 1st of the upcoming month. Monthly billing will continue until the office receives written notice. Tuition is due for the month in which you drop
- **Discounts** - Receive a 10% discount and or a 15% discount for one of the following: -Multiple Class Discount: For students taking two or more classes in the same term -15% Family Discount: For families registering siblings for at least one class each in the same term.
- **Scholarship** -Limited Full and Half Scholarships are available. Families can call SABA Education Department at 325-763-4807 for approval.
- **Class Cancellations/Absences** - SABA reserves the right to cancel any class if enrollment is insufficient. Any tuition paid will be refunded in full. There are no refunds are adjustments on tuition based on absences. Make-up classes are encouraged and must be taken within the month missed. **SABA FOLLOWS THE SAISD SCHOOL CALENDAR.** Classes are based upon 4 classes a month regardless of which day those holidays fall on with the exception of December, January, and May which are half months (monthly tuition is an average based on the fact that some months have 4 weeks and some months have 5 weeks).
- **Recital Fees-** Families are responsible for all costume fees for the recital on May 15th. Costume information will be sent out in early Spring.
